# **Trustees Report**

The parking lot light is fixed by the front entrance. The front entrance has been repainted. It looks so bright!! The entrance doors were repaired in January. In April we had the carpets professionally cleaned. There have already been coffee spill and stains. Please be careful and aware of your drinks in the sanctuary. New LED lights are here for installation in the education wing. Solar panels are here for installation for our security cameras.

**Projects in progress**– The bathrooms down the hallway should be finished by June 4th. We have three people who are working together to get our flashing on the roof repaired when their schedules coordinate. As soon as the fire department returns our call, we will be able to finish the new smoke alarms that are required from our annual safety (fire department) inspection. Then on to the emergency lighting that is also required from our inspection.

A new range will soon be purchased for the parsonage. We do have funds in the budget for this.

Thank you Dave Dorson and Mike Urlaub for lawn mowing. Thank you to Jim Hastings and the cemetery board for the donation of ceiling tiles from their project at the cemetery's office project. Once the roof flashing project is complete, Then we will be able to replace the ceiling tiles and see if we have any additional leads to fix.


