Trustee Update

The church received an annual fire inspection from the Campbell County Fire Department. This year's inspection brought forward that our smoke detectors are in need of replacement. The fire department recommends a system of smoke detectors with a battery backup and need to be connected through Wi-Fi. Also, since it is recommended that we should keep all classroom doors closed to deter fire damage in case of a fire, we are putting in 12 smoke detectors with a wireless battery system. These will cost about \$45 each and are rated to last 10 years. Our insurance company sent us an alarm that will notify trustees (three have been designated) via texts and phone calls through the Wi-Fi system. That way we are aware of the situation immediately and can do what needs to be done for the emergency. If anyone would like to donate to this expense, please mark your donation as smoke alarms.
