The Pastor's Door

How did we get to May already? I believe that three weeks ago was Christmas, and last week was Easter! Yet here we are hoping that winter and the cold weather will finally break, and spring can happen here in Gillette. This is the time of the year that we all get rather antsy. We know that spring is on its way, school is almost over for many, and summer travel plans are being finalized as we travel across the state and the country during the brief three months of summer.



But what will you do if your summer plans don't work out as you hoped? Will you be upset, angry, sad, or maybe you will be calm and accept everything with aplomb? It reminds me of Jesus and his disciples crossing the Sea of Galilee from the Gospel of Luke. If you need a reminder of this story, it is in Luke 8:22-25, but basically Jesus tells his disciples to cross the sea and a storm comes up and Jesus is sound asleep. The disciples fret and worry, waking Jesus up to tell them that they are afraid to die. Jesus calms the sea and asks the disciples a question that I often reflect on "Where is your faith?" (Luke 8:25). This is a question I often ask myself and sometimes I do not like the answer because I am ashamed that I have doubted what God is doing in my life.

All too often we want things to go as we planned them; trips, career paths, family life, etc. and often plans are disturbed and thrown out the window. Yet what about God's plan for you? Are you saying that you know better the God about what you need to be doing? The disciples were scared because a storm came upon them, and they had no idea what God would do in that moment. What will God do for you this summer by changing your plans?
