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Guidelines for Quiet Disciple Award Nomination

1. The nominee is an active layperson, a member/on the rolls of this local United Methodist Church.
 2. The nominee displays a strong Christian commitment in many aspects of his/her life, not just the ministries for which he/she is being recognized.
 3. The nominee is a resident of the local church's community and has demonstrated the characteristics of a Quiet Disciple.
 4. The nominee is willing to have his/her ministry recognized. *
 5. His/her local church recommends the nominee.
 6. A brief commentary on why this individual deserves to be recognized as a Quiet Disciple. (Biographical information must be limited to approximately 150 words. Should there be a significantly longer commentary, the lay leaders or the conference coordinators have authority to edit at their discretion.)
 7. The completed nomination form is to be forwarded to the district/sub-district lay leader by the assigned deadline. (Please reference the accompanying cover letter for that person's name, addresses, and return deadline.)
- Some people prefer to remain relatively anonymous, so please ASK the nominee whether he/she will accept the award before you send in the nomination. Each person nominated will receive this award. **
- ** This award is considered to be a lifetime achievement award, so it is not awarded a second time. (Exceptions may occur with younger people, and then in later adulthood.)
