## The Pastor's Door

## **Reverend Cory Young**

I have to say that one of the more difficult pieces of ministry for me is to write a monthly newsletter article. It should not be that difficult to come up with something to say, yet so often I am sitting here looking at a blank word processing page wondering to myself "What should I be writing about this month?" Sometimes the words come easily and quickly, and other times I start over three or four times because the words don't feel right. The words should



be perfect, Shakespearian in verse and rhyme, and have every person reading this having their life changed in that moment.

It is a nice dream, but we know that it doesn't work that way. And neither does our faith. If someone has asked you to define your faith and what Jesus means to you, would you be able to verbalize what you are thinking or stumble through your words hoping that you made some sense? We have this fear of sharing our faith, don't we? We feel that we are not good enough, or not trained enough to tell others what God means to us. But you know what? The disciples felt the same way we did!

I often repeat it when talking about the disciples, they did not understand what Jesus was doing. They fought over who Jesus thought was the favorite, they doubted Christ when he healed the sick, they pushed the children away, and yet these are the men (and women) who helped establish God's church. People who struggled, people who doubted, and people who were not perfect.

What we need to do is stop worrying about how good we are, we just need to start doing! I was terrible when I preached my first sermon, I was terrified when I was asked to preside over my first funeral, there was a time I couldn't explain my faith. I just started doing what was asked of me, and so should you.

Here is a secret I can tell you about ministry in any form; no one is perfect at it when they start. We make mistakes, we grow, we educate ourselves, and we become better. I am going to challenge you this month to stop worrying about failing and just start doing. It might not be perfect, it might feel disappointing, yet you are doing something for God and God is pleased with that. Continue to do what God is asking you to do, and know that we are celebrating a loving and living God together.
