

Lots of good news to share. Beginning in late September we partnered with DVR and the school system. We have two students with disabilities that spend one of their class periods with us learning job skills. Kaylee and Gavin have really been a joy to work with.

They awarded us \$3500 more than we requested to be applied for operational expenses. Our income is consistently \$1500 to \$1750 per month, it takes \$1850 to meet expenses. We are so close.
